NEWS FROM DAHL/ARCAHAIE WINTER 2025



Arcahaie School started on a parched hillside known as Dahl Village. The students and staff lived under constant threats from gangs, several times having to flee the school before the violence arrived. Eventually the gangs took over the area, destroying and dismantling the entire school building. For three years, the school moved from one location to the next, seeking only a safe place and some benches for the students to come and learn. Now located in Arcahaie, the 106 children are led by 8 teachers, 2 aids and Principal Dernier. The students study Mathematics, Social Science, Experimental Science, Creole, French, Civics and Moral. Their typical school lunch is rice and beans with sauce. Arcahaie School desperately needs your support.
