Trouforban is one of our most stable villages and has been led well by Pastor Michel Wilzer for the last 17 years. The Village School has 123 children enrolled in Kindergarten through 6th grade. The school employs 9 teachers and 2 aides who teach Mathematics, French, Creole, Social Science, Experimental Science, Bible and Instruction, Civil and Moral studies. Their typical school lunch is rice and beans with sauce.
