Viello is a secluded mountain village, miles above the hustle and bustle of the busy streets along the coastline. Because of its remote location, it is generally free from the majority of gang violence seen in other areas.

There are 133 children currently enrolled in the Viello school. Some travel miles a day up and down the steep slopes to secure their education and have a hot meal each school day. The students study Mathematics, Social Science, Experimental Science, Creole, French, Civics and Moral. Their typical school lunch is rice and beans with sauce.
