Dear Friends of and Sponsors of Cadenette,

In the name of Pastor Frésnel and his wife, I am writing this letter to share with our sponsors the situation currently unfolding in the community of Monwi.

A gang has recently moved into our area, and its presence has directly affected our village. On Monday, October 27, 2025, due to the growing insecurity, parents were forced to temporarily evacuate their children to safer areas.

We are now exercising patience while waiting for the State authorities and security forces to restore order so that we can resume our normal activities. We have already contacted the parents to inform them of the situation and are working to see whether we can restart classes soon, even if it means doing so in a different location. If we abandon the children, many of them will not be able to attend school elsewhere, as their parents cannot afford to pay for another school.

As the leaders responsible for managing the village, we are doing everything possible to resume operations as soon as conditions allow. Finally, we extend our greetings and heartfelt thanks to all the mission leaders, both in Haiti and abroad, especially Pastor Bill and Mr. Jerry.

We pray that God will bless you and all those who contribute to ensure that the children can continue attending school and receive a warm meal to support and comfort them.
