



FROM OUR SCHOOL DIRECTOR

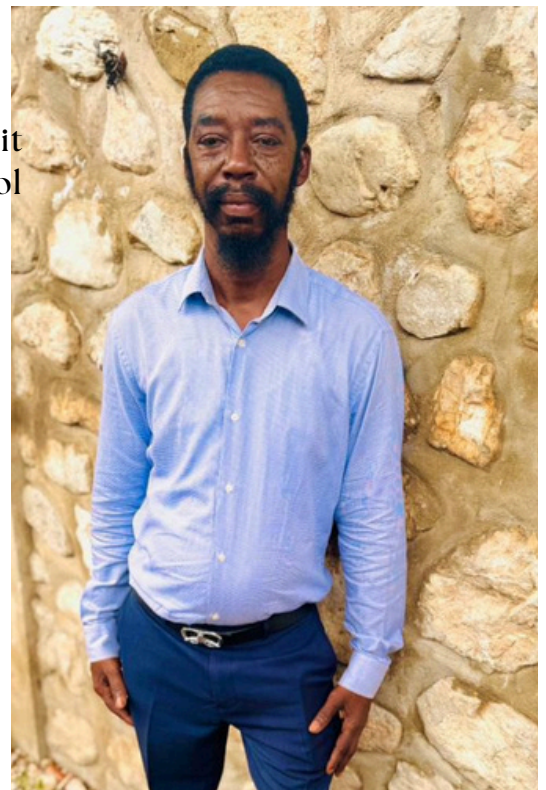
I am Director Michelet Dernier, the Principal of the village school in Archaie.
